

Kites are flying everywhere.



British Easter traditions

-**HOT CROSS BUNS** ARE A DELICIOUS TRADITION IN UK. THESE RAISIN FILLED BUNS ARE TOASTED, LATHERED IN BUTTER AND BEING ENJOYED WITH A NICE CUP OF TEA

-**EGG HUNT**. CHILDREN ALL OVER THE COUNTRY LOOK FORWARD TO THEIR BASKETS OF **EASTER EGGS**, WHICH THEY RECEIVE ON EASTER SUNDAY. CHILDREN ARE TOLD THAT THE EGGS ARE DELIVERED BY THE **EASTER BUNNY**.

- **MAYPOLE DANCING** IS EASTER TIME TRADITION IN BRITAIN – AND IN OTHER PARTS OF THE WORLD TOO. DANCERS HOLD ON TO COLOURFUL **RIBBONS** WHICH ARE ATTACHED THE THE LARGE POLE AND DANCE IN PATTERNS, OFTEN TO LIVE MUSIC PLAYED BY THE VILLAGE BAND. THE TRADITION CERTAINLY COMES FROM OUR **PRE-CHRISTIAN HERITAGE** BUT HAS BEEN A BIG PART OF THE CELEBRATIONS AT EASTER TIMES FOR CENTURIES.
